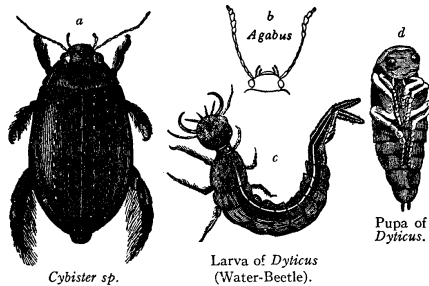

The 2025 Florida Association of Aquatic Biologists Spring Taxonomic Workshop will be held on May 6-8 at the UF Department of Entomology and Nematology, and is being led by John Epler. John is a world-renowned entomologist and works as an independent consultant. He has been working with water beetles for over 20 years, and published a Florida Water Beetle identification manual.



Dr. Short is the Chair and Professor of Insect Biodiversity at the University of Florida, Entomology and Nematology Department. He recently (2023) joined the department. His focus is on the evolution and biodiversity of aquatic insects. Dr. Short received his Ph.D. in Entomology from Cornell University. He has published extensively, especially related to the Hydrophiloidea and will bring his expertise to this workshop.

There will be ample time for lab work to look at specimens and get verifications. Be sure to make plans now to be a part of this great workshop. Due to the size of the teaching lab where we will be meeting, **workshop attendance is limited to thirty (30) persons**, so be sure to register today via the website. The workshop will begin at 1:00 PM on Tuesday, May 6, 2025, and conclude before lunchtime on Thursday, May 8, 2025.

Location:

As with many of our recent freshwater workshops, this one will be held at the excellent teaching laboratory of the University of Florida Department of Entomology and Nematology (Charles Steinmetz Hall) on the UF campus in Gainesville. The address is shown above. When attending the workshop, be sure to park to the **right** of the entrance drive, or behind the building. If you park to the left of the main entrance, you will be ticketed.

Workshop cost:

\$70 for FAB members, \$125 for non-members, and \$45 for students

- Student-quality dissecting microscopes are available at the teaching lab. Participants may bring their own scopes, if desired. Be sure to bring specimens for identification or verification.
